About the role:

You will supervise and support students and work alongside the Pastoral Team to support student integration. You should have significant and successful experience of working with children with challenging behaviour and possess excellent management and organisational skills, combined with the ability to prioritise time and tasks in order to meet deadlines and provide a friendly and efficient service.

Duties will include:

- Providing particular support for pupils and access to learning
- Supporting pupils to overcome barriers to learning
- Establishing good relationships with pupils and their families/guardians, and responding to individual needs
