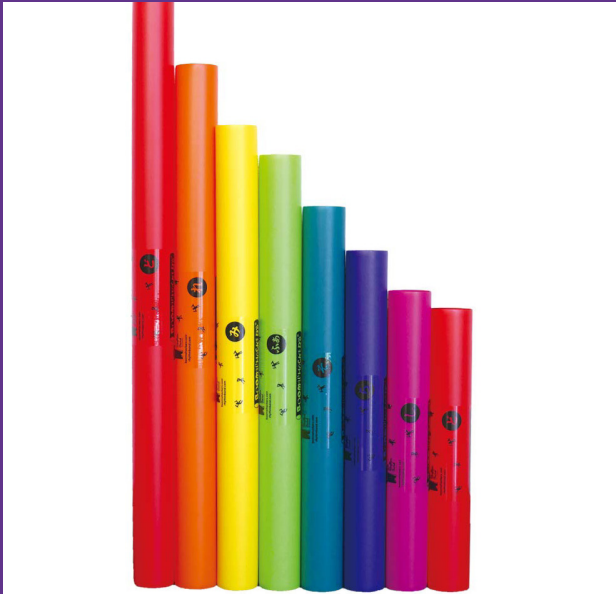

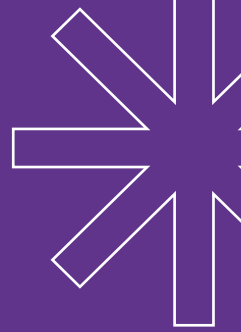
MUSIC

It involves a sequence of physical activities that are designed to alert, organise and calm.

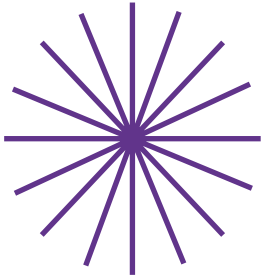
The sensory circuit aims to facilitate sensory processing to help children regulate and organise their senses in order to achieve the optimum level of alertness required for effective learning.
